She is also an SFHEA (Senior Fellow of Advance HE, UK), reflecting her high impact in teaching and learning worldwide, and an SAP Certified Business Associate.

Her teaching and research portfolio spans undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral levels, reflecting a strong commitment to academic excellence and innovation. She serves as an active member of the Permanent Scientific Committee for Professors Promotion at AASTMT and played a pivotal role in achieving AACSB accreditation. She maintains an extensive scholarly record, with over 100 publications, including a book, book chapters, journal articles, and international conference papers.

Prof. Rasha has supervised more than 38 PhD, DBA, MSc, and MBA theses across the UK, Spain, Sweden, and Egypt. She continues to act as both an internal and external examiner for doctoral and master's research at several universities.

Prof. Rasha is the Principal Investigator for several internationally funded projects in collaboration with UK universities, including Coventry, Brunel, and Northumbria. These projects focus on digital inclusion, transnational education, and gender equality, reflecting her strong record of international collaboration and leadership.

Beyond academia, Prof. Rasha actively contributes to social responsibility through research and capacity-building initiatives.
